EXAMPLE

I currently give \$40 each week. If I give twice a month (the 5th & 20th), it will be \$80 per deduction. If I give once a month, it will be \$160 per deduction.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT SIMPLIFIED GIVING

Q: When will the funds be taken from my account?

A: You have the choice of the 5th and or the 20th of each month.

Q: What if the 5th or the 20th fall on a weekend or Holiday?

A: The funds will then be transferred on the next open bank day.

Q: Can I make changes to my Simplified Giving Authorization?

A: Yes, simply notify Embrace Church in writing a month prior to the funds being taken from the account.

Q: Will these funds appear on my Embrace giving statement?

A: Yes, they will appear just as any other offering would appear.

Q: How will I know that the money came out of my account?

A: Your bank statement will reflect an automatic payment to Embrace Church similar to any other electronic payments that occur on your account.

Q: Is my Simplified Giving Authorization information confidential?

A: Yes, the information is kept in the same strict confidence as all other gifts.

Q: How can I begin?

A: It's simple.
