5. What gifts have been given to you by God?
6. What position do you need to be in to receive God's love?
7. Do you ever question God's love for you because of your actions?
8. Travis explained two different types of people: the broken person and the church person. Which one do you relate with most? Why?

Action:

Take time to pray for a revelation in your heart and in the hearts of those around you specifically regarding the idea that we cannot work for God's love. His love is a gift, not a wage.
