A long-time dream came to life in November with the launch of a God Behind Bars Campus inside the Mike Durfee State Prison in Springfield, SD.

Each Monday evening, Chuck, Embrace's Durfee Campus Pastor, and a team of volunteers travel to the prison for an Embrace service and message. Each week, Chuck and the team report back on conversations with the men how the services have been encouraging and uplifting them.

We're praying the Durfee Campus is just the beginning of our weekly prison ministry. Please pray with us that God opens doors for future opportunities with local prisons & penitentaries.





It's hard to put a number on what God has done at Embrace over last 12 months, but here a re a few highlights:


30 people completed the Here I Am Leadership class last spring.

OUR FAVORITE DAY OF THE YEAR

The Adult Baptism Sundays we hold twice a year continue to be some of our favorite days of the year. In 2023, **238 people** took the step of getting baptized. We thank God for each and every person and can't wait to see how God works in and through their lives in the years to come.



REVERSE OFFERING

In December, we gave away \$60,000 to our people to "go do Jesus stuff." Now in its fourth year, we continue to be amazed by the creative ideas people find to bless the strangers and neighbors around them.

Here's one of the many stories:


I see a man walking to work at the same time every morning when I take my daughter to school. He made an impact right away because I noticed he had a significant limp. I first saw him in August and thought when the weather changed I wouldn't see him walking, but I did. Finally, the Thursday after we received the Reverse Offering, I dropped my daughter off at school then flipped around, (and kinda cut off his path if you will!) walked up and introduced myself.

I originally started fundraising with my Reverse Offering money to buy a bike or electric scooter. Then fundraising became so much more that we aimed for a vehicle. In total, we raised \$13,353 and with the help of a local dealership were able to get him a reliable used vehicle.

I ultimately got in contact with him from his employer's logo on his clothing. Something I haven't shared yet is that he and I have stayed in touch. I discovered from getting coffee with him that he had been working 107 hours per week (legitimately) for over a year just to make ends meet. He was riding a city bus to work and walking from there, and most months couldn't afford phone minutes. Because of all the connections that were made, he got a new job that pays more and allows for better hours and time off to spend with his child which is absolutely incredible!

I'm honestly really grateful that the Lord was at work in all of this. Without Him, none of this would have been possible.

WEDNESDAY NIGHTS ARE THRIVING!

One of the biggest areas of growth over the past year has been at our middle & high school ministries on Wednesday nights. Each week, hundreds of students gather for worship, small group time and of course, a crazy game or two. Here are some our favorite highlights of the year: **439 students** attended e/y in one night - the highest attendance ever! **46 students** were baptized. **260 students** attended a weekend retreat. 2024 is off to a great start for our students as 100 high school students (it's sold out!) head to Camp Castaway in Detroit Lakes, MN on President's Day weekend. "My son has grown so much from going to e/y! Every time he gets in the car afterwards he tells us everything that you talked about and what it means to him. I can't thank the leaders enough for taking time to instill the presence of Jesus & God and the impact it's had on our family."

In 2023, we gave 98 kids a Bible! Their parents and other Embrace families cheering them on as they completed an obstacle course on their way to pick up their very own Action Bible.




GROUPS: MAKING A LARGE CHURCH FEEL SMALL
