



## WEEK ONE OF FOUR

### TIME WITH OTHERS

Want to take the message a little further? Get together with a group of friends, co-workers or family and talk about the message! These questions will help you dive into the word as you grow in community with others.

Simply watch the message, get together with a group of people, and read the questions. If you're feeling really crazy, try praying before and after you meet. God will be there with you!

- 1 What's an experience you've had or piece of knowledge (serious or not serious) that you love telling others about?
- 2 The word gospel means "good news." It was a word that was used to announce victory in battle. Share a time when you received good news. How did it make you feel?
- 3 Read Ephesians 2:1-10. What parts of this passage stand out to you? Which verses do you have questions about?
- 4 Practically speaking, what is the difference between being bad and being dead? Why is it important to realize that we are dead without Christ instead of simply bad without Christ?
- 5 In Ephesians 2 the words "but God" are a turning point that changes the direction from bad news to good news. What is the good news in this passage? How did God accomplish the good news? Be honest with yourself, on a scale from 1 to 10 (with 10 being the highest), how excited does this good news make you feel?
- 6 We can't do anything to earn our salvation, but that doesn't mean we don't try. What are some ways that church-goers try to still earn their salvation instead of simply placing their faith in Jesus?



## **TIME WITH GOD**

There is probably nothing that will grow your faith more than simply spending time with God each day. This is a 7-day devotional that will take you deeper into the message. Together we'll study a passage each day that points to Sunday's message.
